PCNC has booked this year's track event at Spring Mountain Motorsports Ranch in Pahrump, Nevada. Located about 51 miles from the Orleans Casino Hotel, the Fun Rally has used this 2.2 mile road course in years past. It is under brand new management and they have gone out of their way to accommodate us on Thursday and Friday, April 28 and 29.
