We have a party room in the back which is rentable and fits 12-15 people. For the Pro sims (we have 18), it's \$69/hour and the Esports (we have 10), are \$59/hour. But, we give a 10% discount for groups. The party room is \$250 for 2-3 hours.

We don't have food ourselves but there are plenty of restaurants around that people tend to cater from like Bar 'Louie'.

For groups of 20 or more we always recommend a venue booking. With venue bookings, you have the whole store and lounge area with our 98" tv's for anything your group desires to do. We can also curate the driving experiences to your group so you can enjoy more car and track combinations.

For a store rental it's \$2800 for 2 hours Monday through Thursday and \$3000 on weekends for 2 hours.
