The tech session for the conversion will be this spring prior to the Reno Rally. There will be two teams to perform the selected change. The rectangle light demands cutting of the bucket face and we are not yet certain of the cuts needed for the round units. Cut pieces will be given to the car owner in the event complete restoration is planned later (reweld).
