We're at the end of another year and an opportunity to reflect on the last five years. We've seen lots of changes.

First, we have a new name, Orange County Panteras, that reflects where we are and why we are. Team Pantera Orange County served us well for over 30 years, but our new name aligns with all of our on-line names and addresses including our website, email, and financial transactions. We now have our own chapter email account and PayPal account with our name.

We have a new newsletter platform at MailChimp that allows us to create and distribute a graphical based monthly newsletter with analytics that helps us know how effectively we're communicating with our members and knowing what's most important to you.

We are a healthier chapter with more members, more participation in our events and monthly meetings, and on a much better footing financially with two years run rate in our treasury.

After bouncing around for awhile, we have a new home for the last few years at 17th Grill in Tustin. It affords us great food and a private room to hold meetings and events.

We do a better job of planning with a written agenda for all our Board meetings, written minutes that are reviewed and approved each month, a written budget for each year that's reviewed each month to help us stay on track and also invest financially in certain events to improve the experience for our members.

For all five years, we've had a full year calendar of monthly events that tells our members what activities to expect for the entire year.

We have new graphical/video based monthly meetings with Headlights and Taillights, monthly financial summaries, past event videos, collector car videos, and more. We have more guest speakers including David Adler, Lance Nist, Matt Stone, and Pantera vendors like Scott Bell.

Hopefully, we do a better job of communicating with you, our members. Besides the new newsletter, we have event flyers in a convenient 4X6 post-it-on-your-refrigerator format. Regular email reminders and event follow ups.

Let's not forget about monthly events! We continue to support favorite annual events like the Gondola Cruise and Christmas Brunch, and have added some new favorites like the Valentines Breakfast, PI Motorsports Open House and the Old Time Ice Cream Social.

Besides the annual events, Private garage tours have become very popular with two this last year, a Poker Run with three great stops and lunch afterwards, but the highlight of the year was the Meet & Greet with Jay Leno!

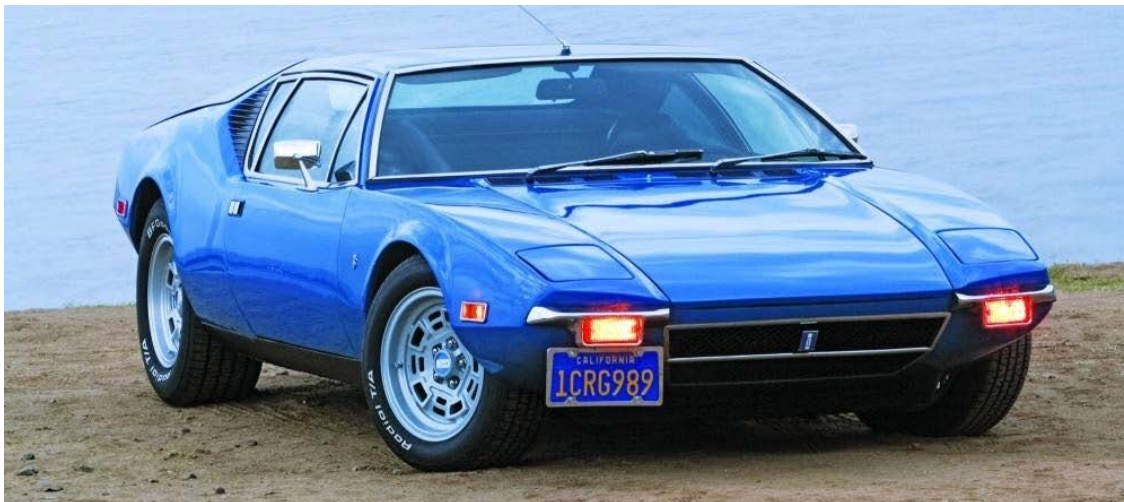
Our signature event now is Pantera Palooza, the largest deTomaso car show in the world! We are already planning for the fifth Palooza! This regional
