announce that TEAM PANTERA OF ORANGE COUNTY has become the first official chapter of the Pantera Owners Club of America." From the beginning, the name had some controversy, and wasn't a unanimous choice, but it has served us well for 32 years.

Since then, lots has changed. Years ago, we created a website at ocpanteras.com, and more recently an email account at ocpanteras@gmail.com. We distributed this monthly newsletter from MailChimp.com using our ocpanteras@gmail.com email account, and we accepted payment for our Christmas Brunch at our PayPal account, also at ocpanteras@gmail.com.

Earlier this year, by vote of the members, we added the names Orange County Panteras and OC Panteras to our By-Laws. We started using OC Panteras in our monthly newsletter, and we created a new chapter banner promoting ocpanteras.com and displayed it at our monthly meetings.

The Board feels it's time to bring our chapter name into alignment with all our on-line names. The change was first announced at our November general meeting.

Starting January 2019, we will become Orange County Panteras.

The Collector Car Market

Pantera prices seem to have stabilized recently, with the cost of 'drivers' coming back into the price range that ordinary collectors can afford. Likewise, Mangustas have returned to more manageable levels. Some of these changes have happened faster than price guides could track. If you haven't looked at your insurance evaluation, add it to your list of year end things to do. Our own Jerry Sackett is a good source for up to the minute evaluations.

Keith Martin, editor of Sports Car Market, recently wrote about collector car trends, "The most notable change is what I see happening at auctions, where late model cars – such as limited production Porsches and Ferraris are in greater demand. There appears to be a new generation of collectors, just hitting their 40s, who have made some money and are entering the market for the first time with very different personal tastes and opinions regarding which cars are most desirable.

This new generation of auto enthusiasts appears to be less interested in "classics" such as a Lamborghini Countach or a Ferrari 250 SWB, and much more interested in owning a Porsche GT3 RS or a Ferrari 599. This appears to be part of the normal evolution in market demand for collector cars. There is nothing that can be done to change or fight these trends, so it's important for collectors to stay informed and to plan and adapt accordingly."

So, where does the Pantera fall? It's clearly not a SWB Ferrari

or a Pebble Beach Duesenberg.....but also not a Porsche GT3. If you want something you can drive and enjoy with timeless style, Panteras are a great choice!
